POINTS TO BE NOTED BEFORE APPLYING

1) The candidate must have passed his MS/DNB (GENERAL SURGERY).

2) The candidate must be within 5 years of completing the degree in surgery.

3) The applicant must be a member of ASI/GSC ASI before the application.

4) The candidate must be of Gujarat domicile.

5) The candidate must not be Mch, DrNB(super-speciality), Or FNB

6) The candidate can get this fellowship only once in his lifetime, he can apply again if he was previously rejected in the selection process.

7) There shall be notification by the Fellowship board via GSSA at least 1 month prior to the date of interview.

8) The panel shall decide the mode of the interview including written / oral viva / interview.

9) The date of interview shall be informed well in advance to the candidate.

10) The candidate will have to bear the expenses for the fair/accommodation for the interview.

11) Upon selection, the candidate will get a total of Rs. 1,00,000/- (One lakh only).

There will be two fellowships each year, and the duration of the fellowship shall be for a minimum of 1 month.

12) The candidate has to present a brief report in the yearly GUJasicon meeting for 10 minutes with presentations and photographs.

13) The candidate shall be given a medal/certificate at the GUJASICON.

14) The training shall consist of basic to advanced minimal invasive surgery, basic endoscopy and a wide variety of open surgeries.

15) The candidate shall be posted as a fellow/observer in the respective department under the department head of the particular institute.

16) The candidate will have to bear the expenses of food and accommodation (however, the institute shall guide/help the fellow)

17) The plan of fellowship will be decided by mutual discussion of the candidate and committee members.
